NOTE: The Exterior Grant Reward Program (EGR) is an incentive program to promote resident investment as a means of neighborhood revitalization. The EGR Program was developed to allow homeowners already completing an interior/exterior property improvement project(s) an opportunity for additional exterior property improvements. Only homeowners who have completed an interior/exterior improvement project(s) in 2012 and reside within the boundaries of CBP's six targeted renewal areas are eligible to receive funding. The EGR Program **does not** provide funding assistance towards a property improvement. The funds are designed to provide funding for an additional stand alone project(s) after an initial project(s) exceeding \$3,000 has been completed in 2012.

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Disbursement Procedures

- CBP can be billed by the contractor in which CBP will pay the contractor directly for services rendered on behalf of the homeowner.
