Fulton Parkside: Mother's Memorial Garden

In conjunction with ArtsinStark, CBP is embarking on placing public art pieces in six strategic neighborhoods in the NW and NE through our "One Artist, One Organizer, One Neighborhood Approach".

One of the projects currently in development is a Mother's Memorial Garden located on a vacant lot in the eight hundred block of Brown Ave. NW. The artist associated with this project is Blu Lewis, who has captured the ideas of the residents in perfect fashion. The concept behind the project is to create an enclosed destination site for residents with decorative flower beds representing the favorite flowers of mothers from the neighborhood. In addition, inspirational says will be engraved in the sides of the beds. The garden will be enclosed with bamboo fencing. A wrought iron gate will serve as the garden entry way. The garden will be decorated with colorful rocks, decorative benches, stepping stones and a weeping cherry tree.

The Fulton Parkside residents have already approved the design and will begin the initial preparation for the construction of the garden in Summer 2011.
