Fulton Parkside Mother's Memorial Garden Work Days

The residents of Fulton Parkside are getting close to seeing their project become a reality. This project, known as the Mother's Memorial Garden began in October 2010. Since then residents of Fulton Parkside (N: 10th St NW /S: 8th St NW /W: Monument Ave NW /E: Fulton Rd NW) have been planning, dreaming and waiting for the thought of a garden to become a tangible destination for their neighborhood.

Over the past several weeks residents and volunteers from Canton City Schools have been working very hard to finalize the project. As a template, the residents have used the original drawings from local artist Blu Lewis but have made their own modifications throughout the process. Thus far the lot has been leveled on behalf of Marshall Land Company, the entry way gate and metal fencing have been constructed, the fence posts have been set, the path has been created, the rear garden has been weeded and mulched, and the painted rocks now line the path and garden. With only a few projects left to complete the Mother's Memorial Garden looks to be on timeline for completion in August.

As an added bonus to Canton artists, the residents have agreed to open the fence along the alley as a "open canvas" for artists to paint a "mother inspired" art piece on the fence.
